## REMINDERS – Gospel Transformation for Good Works

Titus 3:1-15

March 6, 2022

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### STUDY GUIDE QUESTIONS

- In vs 2 Paul urges believers to be peaceable, considerate, gentle, and to not slander. How can you as an individual work to live this out? How can we collectively as a small group and as a church work to live this out?
- Paul describes our life before Christ in vs 3. What in vs 3 best characterized your life before being saved? If it's tough to remember, you can pivot the question to what your life would likely be characterized by today without Christ?
- In vs 4-7 Paul walks us through the process of our salvation. If you have not shared your salvation testimony as a small group, or if you have new members in your group, this would be a great time to share that story in 2-3 minutes per person. If you have, it can still be a good practice to revisit that as a 1-2 minute salvation testimony. This is the greatest work that God has done in our lives, we can't talk about it too much.
- When you hear "be devoted to doing what is good" what comes to mind right away? Is this an area where the Holy Spirit is prompting movement in your life?
- Why does Paul include the words "careful" and "devote" as he tells Titus that those who have trusted in God should do what is good?
