Dear Fellow Servant,

As the Apostle Paul wrote in his letters, "Grace and peace to you." I used to think that he simply said "Greetings." But when I looked it up, I realized that his greeting was actually — "Grace and peace to you."

You never know what you will find when you start diligently searching God's Word!

As disciples of Jesus Christ, we all need to spend time discovering what the Lord is "saying" to us. This little booklet is one small tool for you to use. I hope you will learn many new things through your own searching of the Scriptures.

Each week, you will have a Bible verse at the top of the page that captures the one word being emphasized for the month. Can you tell me the special word for this month? (Hint: It's on the front of this book.)

Did you know that we can talk to God by using His Word, the Bible? We can also hear from God by using His Word as well.

For example, someone could say, "Lord, when I am afraid, I will trust in You. In You God, whose words I praise, in You I trust. I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?"
