THE PURPOSE OF LIFE GROUPS

FOUR ESSENTIAL PARTS OF EVERY LIFE GROUP MEETING

Opening Up – Building community in my Life Group

Each week we'll take time to share what is happening in our lives. At first this sharing will include planned "sharing questions". But after the first few weeks, it will become more informal and personal as we feel more comfortable.

Digging In - Growing through God's Word and God's people

Each week we'll study a section from God's Word that relates to the previous weekend's sermon or an appropriate personal growth topic. Our goal is to learn how to live out our Christianity in everyday life.

Living Out - Taking steps to become a mature disciple of Christ

Each week we'll talk about how to implement what we have learned in practical steps. The group will encourage each to follow through.

Looking Up - Talking with God about myself and my Life Group

We will commit to praying together as a group for the needs of those in my group.

Life Group Values

Safe Environment - to help create a safe place where people can be heard and feel loved. Please, no quick answers, snap judgments, or simple fixes.

Respect Differences - to be gentle and gracious to people with different spiritual maturity, personal opinions, temperaments, or imperfections. We are all works in progress.

Confidentiality - to keep anything that is shared strictly confidential and within the group, and to avoid sharing improper information about those outside the group.
