 \circ Always in line with Scripture

 $\circ \mathsf{To}$ be tested by the listener

Discernment

Distinguishing between moves of God and influences of the World
Able to warn of false teaching
Keeps the Body from being led astray

• 1 Corinthians 12:27-30

Apostleship

The "office" is no longer available
The "gift" is exceptionally helpful
Effective at taking the gospel across borders and barriers
Entrepreneurial and bold

• Teaching

Communicate for understanding
Always pointing to Jesus
Holding truth and love in tension
Held to a very high standard

• Helping/Service

oPractical and selfless

Work well behind the scenes

oDoesn't draw attention to oneself
