Q: What is a Small Group?

A: A Small Group is a group of 6–12 (average) that meets regularly to be known, be encouraged, and be challenged.

Q: Where do Small Groups meet?

A: Most Small Groups meet in homes and during the week.

Q: How often do Small Groups meet?

A: Each group is different. Some groups meet weekly, others meet every other week. Most take breaks between semesters and during the summer.

Q: What will the Small Groups study?

A: Each group will select curriculum that helps them grow in discipleship. Many groups use the weekly Study Guide that follows the Sunday message.

Q: How long do Small Groups meet?

A: Small Groups are asked to commit for a semester, with the option to reassess at that time.
