BIG IDEA:

Take comfort because God is always at work FOR His people, FOR our good, and FOR our conformity to Christ.

STUDY GUIDE QUESTIONS

- ∞ Why is Romans 8:28-30 here? What comfort is this passage meant to bring from the previous verses?

- ∞ What would you say is the central point or big idea of Romans 8:24-30?

- ∞ Does Paul mean “all things” in the world are “good?” Why or why not?

- ∞ What aspect of “The Golden Chain of Salvation” do you find most difficult to grasp? Which aspect do you find most glorious to celebrate? What’s the most comforting part of this promise? What is the most challenging part to this promise?

- ∞ Where did God “break in” and get your attention in the passage? What are you “hearing” from God? Where is He calling you to repent? What is He calling you to do or believe?

- ∞ Bonus: If God uses evil for His purposes, does this mean that He brings evil upon His people? (Don’t be quick to say no. Was He pleased to “crush His Son?” (Isaiah 53)
