STUDY GUIDE QUESTIONS

- ∞ How do we know God is for us?
- → How does Paul argue from the greater to the lesser in Romans 8:32? What illustration can
 you use that would help encourage another believer?
- ∞ What are the "these things" in verse 31? Be specific.
- ∞ What are some of the "doctrines" that give hope and comfort in this passage? Look specifically in verse 34.
- What are "all these things" in verse 37? Be specific. How does this verse fit with verse 31?
 Which of "those things" are you tempted to believe would separate you from God's love?
- ∞ Where did God "break in" and get your attention in the passage? What are you "hearing" from God? Where is He calling you to repent? What is He calling you to do or believe?
- ∞ Bonus: Can an individual lose their salvation? Why or why not?
