BIG IDEA:

We are infinitely secure in Christ because of His perfect work on the cross.

STUDY GUIDE QUESTIONS

- → Have you struggled with God's love? Or eternal security? How does this chapter help? How
 can we know we are eternally secure?
- → How does "no condemnation" relate to the doctrine of justification? (Explain what "justification" means for those who may not know).
- ∞ What are the four things in Romans 8:3 that God does for those who are "in Christ?" Talk through and discuss. Spend time praising God for His work.
- ∞ What would you say is the central point or big idea of Romans 8:1-4? What's God trying to communicate about you? About Him?
- Where did God "break in" and get your attention in the passage? What are you "hearing" from God? Where is He calling you to repent? What is He calling you to do or believe?
- Bonus: How much of the Law did Jesus accomplish on your behalf? If Jesus accomplished
 all of the law, does that mean that we aren't under His Moral Law (i.e. 10 Commandments)?
 Explain why or why not.
